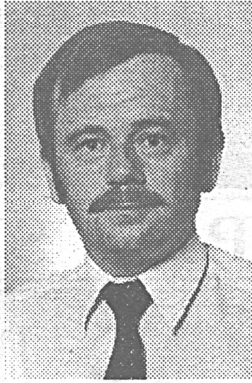


Gieras Named Fellow
